

# Worksheet: Minnesota Questions Tool Protocol

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The released questions from previously administered Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCAs) within the [Minnesota Questions Tool \(MQT\)](#) offer valuable opportunities for teachers to understand the student assessment experience and can help expand their own classroom assessment practice by understanding the different ways of eliciting evidence of what students know and can do regarding the Minnesota state standards.

Navigate through the MQT, and search for sample questions by the subject and grade level of your choice. You may wish to also sort questions by strand or substrand, Depth of Knowledge (DOK) levels, or by testing year. Then, select a question type from the provided list that you are interested in exploring further. Use the protocol to reflect on how this information can help support your students.
